We have also established collaborations with global partners through **EUNICE AISBL** (*legal entity*), as they cannot operate directly under Erasmus+ rules.





What are the geographical areas of interest in your present and/or future strategy? hird countries **not associated** with the Erasmus + Programme






Alliances' Survey: Collaboration Challenges

- > Lack of an EU-wide framework for non-EU collaboration
- ➤ Funding fragmentation and sustainability gaps (KA 171-CBHE, EMundus, etc.)
- Legal and administrative barriers to joint education and mobility (no legal entity)
- Cultural and communication differences in management, incl. a lack of infrastructure
- ➤ Limited internal strategies and resources, HR, coordination and decision-making within Alliances


Cooperation – funding overview

Is your Alliance cooperation strategy with non-EU countries linked to specific funding?






Have you applied for additional funding sources?
